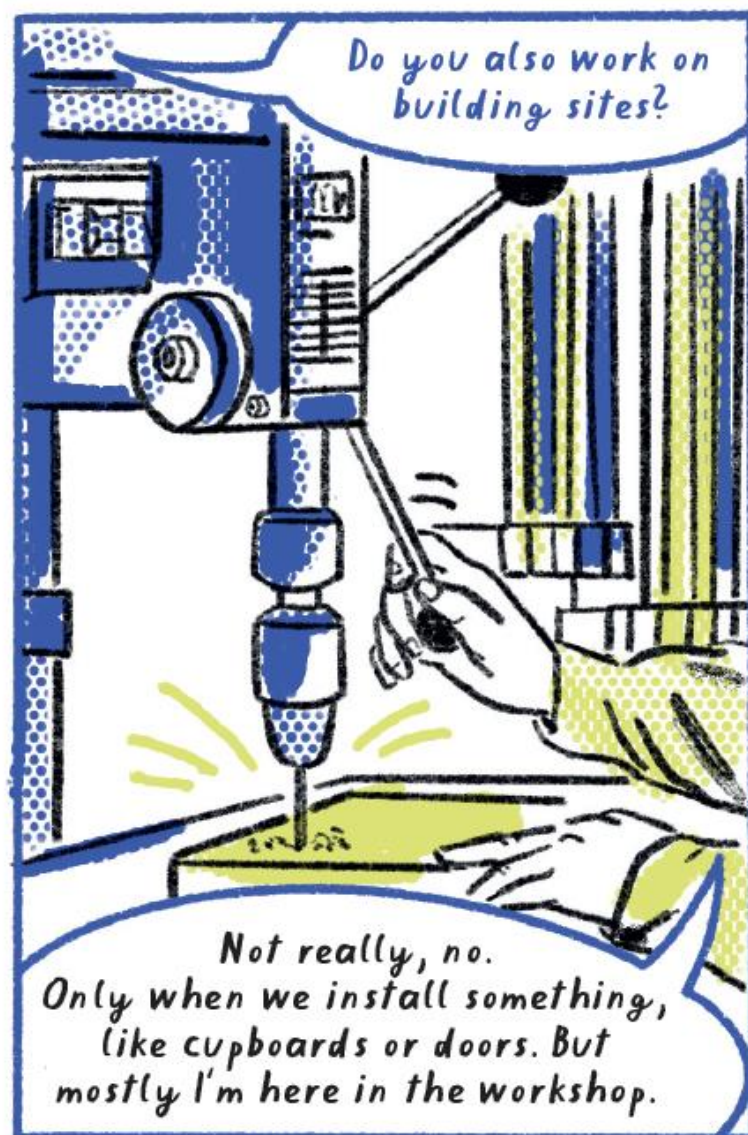
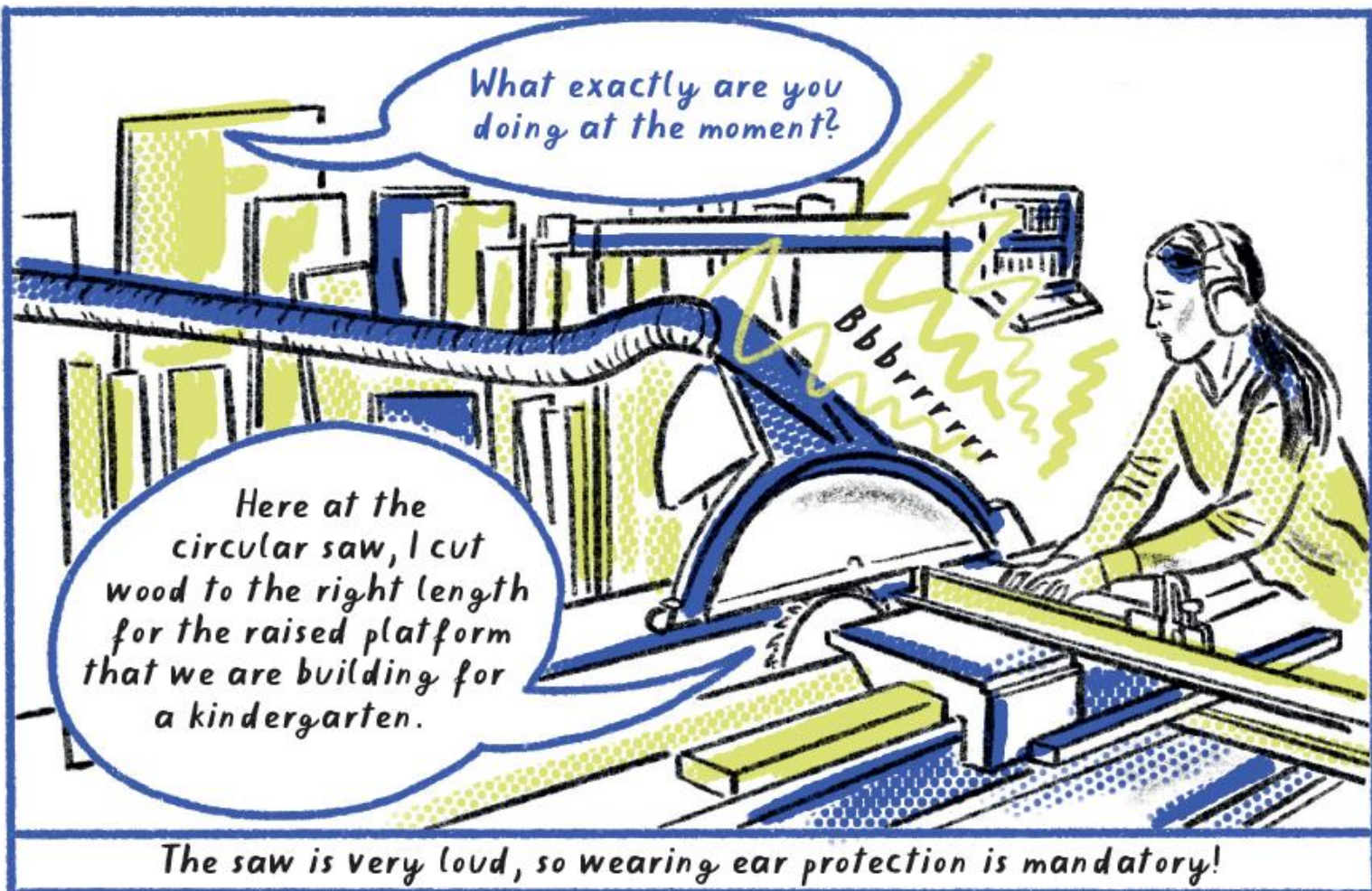
Why did you choose this profession?
